06-600-150 Temperature Controller

The ATMOX Temperature Controller is designed to operate ATMOX fans under high heat conditions, typically in an attic. The Temperature Controller must be mounted or placed in the space being monitored.

A power source will be connected to Temperature Controller via low voltage cable but can be mounted in any place with a standard electrical outlet. It does not need to be the attic or space to be ventilated.



Fans will operate when heat reaches 95 degrees Fahrenheit. Fan operation will remain continuous until sensor reading drops several degrees below this temperature level. Contact ATMOX for any change in temperature trigger point.

- One set of Red/Black Banana Plugs is included.
- One set of Purple/Black Banana Plugs is included.

Max Watts: 150 watts

Use only approved ATMOX Fans and Accessories with the ATMOX Temperature Controller.

Installing the ATMOX Temperature Controller

- Mount Temperature Controller with screws through two mounting holes.
- For proper operation, the Temperature Controller should be mounted 3 to 4 feet away from the roof deck in the attic to avoid incorrect sensor readings.

The ATMOX Temperature Controller is designed to be used with the ATMOX Power Supply or AC Adapter with Plugs. The maximum number of fans will depend on the watts used by each fan and the power source. See details on each fan on ATMOX Fan Specification Sheet.

For Wiring Instructions, refer to Installation Guide for Power Supply and AC Adapter with Plugs.

Testing the Fans

The fans should be tested to make sure that they are all working properly and that all wiring has been done correctly.

- If the interior temperature is above 95 degrees at time of install, all fans should begin operation.
- If the interior temperature is below 95 degrees, the fans can be tested by bypassing the temperature controller. Plug the red and purple banana plugs together instead of into the Temperature Controller. This will allow a full connection directly from the Power Supply. All fans should now begin operation.



LIMITED THREE-YEAR WARRANTY

When installed, operated, used and maintained as intended in residential applications and according to the instructions supplied with ATMOX products, ATMOX warrants its products for a period of 3-years from the date of purchase against any defects in material and workmanship. The products covered by this warranty include the control boxes, fans, sensors and wiring manufactured by ATMOX. ATMOX will repair or replace, at ATMOX's option, any ATMOX product or component found to be defective within the 3-year warranty period.

ATMOX products are designed to improve conditions in the crawlspace, basement or attic, yet are limited by atmospheric and natural conditions over which ATMOX has no control and which are not covered by this warranty. ATMOX products are not warranted against damage caused by electrical surges, fire or other casualty, vandalism, or acts of God (including lightning strikes and floods). This warranty does not make representations regarding mold, insects, termites, water, rot, electrical, HVAC, roof, framing, foundation, floors, drywall, gutters, ice dams or other problems that may occur in a house structure. The warranty does not include any costs of removal or reinstallation.

Third-party products by other manufacturers sold by ATMOX (such as dehumidifiers) are not covered by this warranty but may be covered under separate warranties by the product's manufacturer. Purchaser should contact third party manufacturers for warranty claims and coverage of third-party products not manufactured by ATMOX.
